## WEATHER ADVISORY

Weather Advisory will be issued to advise the public and relevant agencies for the likelihood of unsettled weather conditions occurring.

For example, Weather Advisory shall be issued when synoptic-scale weather influences, such as tropical depression or typhoon systems, are identified to develop within our region of concerned and have the potential to affect Brunei Darussalam.

BDMD will continue monitoring and updating the development of the weather situations upon the issuance of Weather Advisory. Members of the general public and relevant agencies should therefore keep an eye on BDMD's latest weather forecasts and updates.


## UNDERSTANDING WEATHER WARNING \& WEATHER ADVISORY

Weather Advisory will only be issued when there is a potential active weather expected for a certain period of time.

When the liketihood of active weather increases and severe weather is expected to pose a threat to Brunei Darussalam, then Weather Warning shall be issued immediately.

Hence, Weather Warning will only be issued when there is high confidence of a severe weather occurring with potential risk of disaster.

Any Weather Warning issued can be upgraded (in terms of warning stages) should severe weather persists or increases in severity.

The duration of Weather Warning can also be extended when severe weather is expected to persist.

Weather Warning can be downgraded or terminated completely when weather condition is expected to improve.
